0005	Farm: Nursery Emp. & Drivers	Operations including planting, fertilizing, watering trimming and transplanting of lawns, trees, shrubs & plants
0042	Landscape Gardening	Laying out grounds, sodding, seeding, planting and similar work including beautification of roadsides in connection with street or road construction
0050	Farm/Weed Spraying/Conserv Dist	Contractors engaged in the rental & operation of agricultural machinery & equipment - site preparation of right of ways Weed spraying by mechanical equipment Includes Mountain Pine Beetle project
0106	Tree Pruning, Spraying & Repairs	Contractors using hand tools or mechanical equipment to prune, spray, repair, trim or fumigate trees.
0170	Animal Shelters	Animal raising & drivers - applies to fur bearing animals Caretakers at a dog pound
0251	Irrigation Works Operation & Drivers	Operation and maintenance of irrigation & drainage systems Maintenance of pumps, cleaning of ditches, including the spreading of spraying in connection with mosquito control.
3724	Machinery or Equipment Erection & Repair	Repair of heavy machinery. Installation of traffic signals
5192	Parking Meters/Vending Machines	Parking meter collections and repairs
5403	Carpentry	Carpentry work - applies to repairs on wooden bridges
5506	Street & Road Const Incl Snow	Paving, repaving, surfacing, resurfacing or scraping, patching streets, pothole repairs sand & gravel haulers, including airport runways. Includes Street Cleaning and Snow Removal
5507	Street & Road Subsurface	Clearing right of ways, earth excavation, filling or grading
5606	Contractors Exec. Supr/ Hwy Supt	Superintendents having administrative or managerial responsibility
6217	Grading (Landfill)	Filling, backfilling, grading, excavation - LANDFILLS
6229	Irrigation or Drainage System Construction and Driver	New or repair work on irrigation or drainage systems
6319	Gas Mains (Incl. Drivers)	Utility Company - construction or installation of mains.
7370	Paid Ambulance Service/EMT's	Ambulance service companies not operated by hospitals
7370a	Volunteer Ambulance/EMT's	Volunteers - Rated on number of volunteers on roster
7370b	Volunteer Search & Rescue	(Incl. Dive Teams) - Rated on number of volunteers on roster
7370c	Volunteer Emergency Service	Emergency services i.e. sand bagging NO Storm (Tornado) chasers
7370d	CERT Team members	Volunteers that serve on the local CERT Teams
7370e	Volunteers under 18 years old	Any volunteer positions EXCEPT Junior Firefighters
7380	Drivers & Assistants	Bookmobiles
7382	Bus Company	Transit buses; airport buses; trolleys; senior citizens buses; all employees and drivers
7403	Airport Operations	Commercial air carriers - maintenance, service personnel ground personnel, cargo & baggage handlers

7502	Gas Company	Store employees - meter readers
7520	Waterworks	Water plant employees including meter readers
7538	Electrical Underground & Trenching	Burying cable, or any underground electrical work
7539	Electric Light or Power Company	Public light or power companies and meter readers
7360	Public Works - 3 EE's or less	Includes street, water, sewer - when smaller entities have 3 employees or less to do all of the maintenance work
7580	Sewage Disposal	All operations of a sewage disposal plant
7590	Garbage Workers - Recycling Centers	All operations EXCEPT drivers and refuse collectors RECYCLING CENTER for municipality
7600	Telephone/Telegraph Co.	Operation, maintenance, extension of lines and making service connection
7704	Paid Firefighters & Drivers	Paid firemen - actual salary
7704a	Volunteer Fire Fighters	Rated on Number of volunteers on roster
7704b	Jr. Firefighters	Volunteers i.e. Eagle Scout Program They do not drive, do not become involved with fire extinguishment - training position
7705	Wildland Fire - Out of State	Rates are based on the payment fire departments receive by sending their FF's out of State to assist with a fire
7720	Law Enforcement	Includes police officers, correction departments, probation officers, sheriffs and jail employees.
7720a	Reserve Police	Rates are based on the number of volunteer Reserve police
7720b	Volunteer/Senior Reserve Police	Duties assigned by department i.e. house checks
8017	Store Retail	Liquor Store (Receipts of food sales less than 50% of gross receipts)
8227	Contractors Perm. Yard/Warehouse	Storage or maintenance of owned equipment
8380	Auto Service & Repair/Hwy Shop	Mechanical repairs to vehicles; car washes, Municipal garage, County garage where vehicles & heavy equipment are stored and repaired
8392	Parking Lots	Responsible for indoor and outdoor parking facilities
8601	Consulting Engineer	Technical advice of plans, map, charts, etc. in advisory capacity
8742	Salespersons or Collectors - Outside of Office	Duties away from employer's premise Executive Directors; Boy Scout Councils; Newspaper & Magazine Publishers
8810	Clerical Incl. Board Members	Administrative, clerical, librarians, mayor, council or commissioners, police dispatchers, Civil Defense Director (if all office work - if not use Code 9410)
8810a	Volunteer Librarians	Rates are based on the number of volunteer librarians
8820	Attorney	Lawyers, paralegal, court reporters, judges, etc.

9084	Restaurant/Bar/Lounge	Sale of beer, liquor or wine (Receipts of alcoholic sales of beverage more than 50% of entire gross receipts)
9101	School, College, Library, Museum	Employees other than professional - bldg. & grounds maintenance, etc.
9102	Parks/Lifeguards	Lawn mowing, cross country ski trails, swimming pool lifeguards Highway department mowing ditches
9156	Musicians Entertainers Players	Actors, players, entertainers and musicians municipal bands
9220	Cemetery Operations	Mowing, Excavating, back filling, grave moving
9402	Sewer Cleaning/Mosquito Spraying/Misc	Cleaning mainline sewers & storm sewers Outdoor spraying for mosquito or other insects not near irrigation systems.
9403	Garbage or Refuse Collection	Public collection of garbage or refuse
9404	Automated Garbage Service	Automated trucks with drivers only
9405	Semi-Automated Garbage Service	Automated equipment with employees assisting the hydraulic equipment
9410	Municipal, Township, County Employees	Board of Health inspectors, Electrical inspectors tax assessors, director of equalization, zoning administrator, civil defense director - if they track tornados, etc.
9552	Sign Mfg. & Erection	Entire operation of manufacturing and erecting signs.
